THE TWO-FOLD WORK OF JESUS CHRIST:

- CLEANSER OF SIN The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." Jn. 1.29
- BAPTIZER WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT "The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is he who will baptize with the Holy Spirit." Jn. 1.33
- THIS TWO-FOLD WORK OF GOD WAS PROMISED BY THE PROPHETS "Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe my ordinances."

- THE BIBLE TEACHES THAT ALL WHO RECEIVE GOD'S FORGIVENESS ALSO RECEIVE HIS SPIRIT, LIKE TWO SIDES OF THE COIN OF SALVATION. IT IS FOR ALL BELIEVERS.

THE BAPTISM COMES TO ALL BELIEVERS THE MOMENT THEY PUT THEIR TRUST IN CHRIST FOR SALVATION, IT SIGNIFIES OUR ENTRANCE INTO THE NEW COVENANT.

"And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ...those who are led by the Spirit of God are the sons of God...The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.."

THE FILLING WITH THE SPIRIT IS A CONTINUOUS MARK OF THE NEW COVENANT AS THE BAPTISM IS THE INITIAL MARK. THE FILLING IS A COMMAND TO ALL CHRISTIANS.

THE BIBLE TEACHES THAT THE MARK'S OF THE SPIRIT'S FILLING ARE NOT NECESSARILY MIRACULOUS AND SPECTACULAR SIGNS BUT GODLINESS, COMPASSION FOR THE LOST, AND A HUMBLE ATTITUDE; IN SHORT, TO BE FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT IS TO BE LIKE THE LORD JESUS.
