This great affirmation of the Christian faith was begun by the Council of Nicea in 325 and completed by the Council of Chalcedon in 451 A.D. It refuted false teachings about Jesus by declaring the biblical truth that He is fully man and fully God in one person.

Today we at Beijing International Christian Fellowship ZhongGuanCun, with believers around the world, affirm this great creed as a faithful expression of the biblical message. This ancient creed speaks against modern heresies that deny the Lord Jesus Christ His rightful place as

Sovereign Savior and the second person of the Holy Trinity. It is through Jesus that we meet God, and it by the Scriptures that we understand Jesus.
