MANY NOT SURE - HOPEFUL BUT AFRAID - SOME ACCUSE OF ARROGANCE

INITIAL EXCITEMENT OF SALVATION - GREAT CONFIDENCE AND JOY

PASSING FROM DARKNESS INTO LIGHT / DEATH TO LIFE

LATER - DOUBTS ARISE - SAME OLD PERSON, TEMPTATIONS, EVEN WORSE

OLDER CHRISTIANS - ALL GOING WELL - CONFIDENT IN GOD

WORLD CAVES IN - sickness, lose job, death of loved one FAITH SOON CAVES IN TOO

SPIRIT OF OUR AGE - UNCERTAINTY - DOUBT - MISTRUST
RESEARCH DEGREES TO DISPUTE ACCEPTED THEORIES

1 John - WRITTEN TO DEAL WITH ISSUE OF DOUBT

MORAL TEST - God is Light - are you walking in the light?

SOCIAL TEST - God is Love - are you walking in love?

DOCTRINAL TEST - God is True - are you walking in the truth?

### MISTAKE TO MAKE GOD'S ANSWERS CONDITIONED ON OUR OBEDIENCE

I.E. "if you had more faith God would answer your prayer"

OBEY = OUR WILL IS IN HARMONY WITH GOD'S

RATHER - OUR ASKINGIS TO BE PATTERNED ON OBEDIENCE

GOD NEVER PROMISED TO GIVE US EVERYTHING WE EVER WANT

NAME FOR SUCH A PERSON - "SPOILED BRAT"

FOR OUR OWN GOOD WE PRAY ACCORDING TO 5.14

BURDEN - OUR OBEDIENCE IS CONDITION OF ANSWERED PRAYER

BENEFIT - WE HAVE A FATHER IN HEAVEN WHO DESIRES OUR BEST
