End of what we Call 1st Corinthians (at least 2nd Letter), Paul writes...

I will visit you after passing through Macedonia, for I intend to pass through Macedonia, and perhaps I will stay with you or even spend the winter, so that you may help me on my journey, wherever I go. For I do not want to see you now just in passing. I hope to spend some time with you, if the Lord permits. But I will stay in Ephesus until Pentecost... 1 Corinthians 16.5-8



Paul writes this Letter 2nd Corinthians from EPHESUS – Capital Roman Asia Key cities Corinth & Ephesus // Strategic M Hdqtrs for Apostle to GENTILES Paul made Several Trips by LAND > via Macedonia & SEA > direct

Apparently Paul's LAST VISIT did NOT END WELL...

For I made up my mind not to make another painful visit to you. 2 Corinthians 2.1

Then PERHAPS his Follow-Up Letter was MISUNDERSTOOD...

For I wrote to you out of much affliction and anguish of heart and with many tears, not to cause you pain but to let you know the abundant love that I have for you.

No Matter > As we Step into our TEXT – Paul called for COOLING Off period

He will STAY in Ephesus for NOW – sends THIS Letter to Explain and Exhort BEGINS with "Elephant in Room" – Obvious, Sensitive, Primary Question "Why Should we Believe You?"

1. Loving Intentions

No church FRUSTRATED Paul more than Corinth > But he Loved Them! Letters & Visits – All made FREE of CHARGE – Showed Fatherly HEART

- 1.7 Our hope for you is unshaken, for we know that as you share in our sufferings, you will also share in our comfort.
- a. Grace 1.12 not by earthly wisdom but by the grace of God

GRACE is UNCONDITIONAL, UNDESERVED Forgiveness

It is what WE have FREELY Received from the GOD we Unendingly Offend
Paul MODELS the CHRIST he was Following > Demonstrates Grace in Corinth

VS. 8,9 – Paul tells how he ALMOST DIED as he Served as Apostle to Gentiles

CORINTHIAN Army SHOOTS their WOUNDED!

Instead of HONORING Paul they HURT him Some MORE

1.15 Because I was sure of this, I wanted to come to you first, so that you might have a second experience of grace.

PAUL could have STERNLY Exercised his Apostolic Authority > GENTLE

He wants them to have DOUBLE BLESSING –

May mean COMING TWICE – ON his Way TO and Coming FROM Macedonia May mean GRACE OF GIVING – chs 8 & 9 – Give their Collection for POOR

Paul received SUPPORT from HUNGRY Christians in MACEDONIA So he could Preach FREE of CHARGE to the PROUD Corinthians

Plans get you into things, but you have to work your way out! Will Rodgers

1.23 But I call God to witness against me—it was to spare you that I refrained from coming again to Corinth.

NO More PAINFUL VISITS or TEARFUL LETTERS Paul will Just WAIT Like GOD is PATIENT waiting for People to REPENT – So is His Servant Paul NOT Come so they can TAKE Time to REFLECT, REPENT, be RESTORED

b. Joy 1. 24 but we work with you for your joy

Paul was PARENT who was HURT by his SPIRITUAL KIDS

But he does NOT PUNISH in ANGER – Not Hurt because he IS HURT

Swallows his PAIN so they can be RESTORED to TRUE JOY in the LORD

2.1,2 For I made up my mind not to make another painful visit to you. For if I cause you pain, who is there to make me glad but the one whom I have pained?

Paul's RELATIONSHIP with them was DEEP NOT DISTANT

REAL AFFECTION not ALOOF – CONFRONTS them because he CARES

"I MADE Up my MIND" – I Judged for Myself – Thought it BEST Wants them to have GODLY SORROW that leads to LASTING JOY

Paul knows the JOY of the LORD WILL be their STRENGTH
Nothing kills STRENGTH like BITTERNESS and UNFORGIVENESS

2.3 for I felt sure of all of you, that my joy would be the joy of you all.

He will SURRENDER to Bitterness of Lack of Forgiveness – Not Lose His JOY

MINISTERS in LOVE and KINDNESS – Showing JOY – for them to Receive Character of Church will NOT Usually RISE HIGHER than their LEADERS

Argument about CALENDAR soon became ATTACK of his CHARACTER

a. Conscience

Paul BRACKETS his DEFENSE with the WORD BOASTING
Uses word BOAST 3 X's More in 2 Corinthians than any of his Other Letters

Several Times WARNS AGAINST Boasting

God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, so that no human being might boast in the presence of God...so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

1 Corinthians 1.28-31

BOASTING: COMMON in 1st C ROMAN World as SMART Phones Today Paul REBUKES EXCESSIVE, SELF-FOCUSED, GOD-DENYING Boasting Corinthians likely heard Paul's Anti-Boasting Sermon Many Times

Most of the Time in Corinthian SOCIETY – Boasting was UNGODLY Act Roman Soldiers Boasted of their Victories with Wall Murals & Epic Tales PHARISEES Boasted of their VIRTUES and EPIC HOLINESS SUPER-Apostles of Corinth BOASTED of their Credentials & Experiences

NOW gets Attention as OPENS this Letter – NOW, I AM BOASTING

NOT to Make HIMSELF look GOOD > STOOPS to their Level to Save Them

1.12 For our boast is this, the testimony of our conscience, that we behaved in the world with simplicity and godly sincerity

NOT about his SPORTS CAR, BUT his SIMPLICITY NOT about his SHAMEFUL BEHAVIOR but his GODLY SINCERITY

Paul has not been a financial burden in Corinth with his simple lifestyle. And he refused to Sophistic rhetoric...in both word and manner of life he was plain, without ornamentation.

His MOTIVES were PURE and his CONSCIENCE was CLEAR

Paul NOT a SPIN-DOCTOR – Expert in LEGALIZE >> Clear, Simple Preacher

Far from forcing the Corinthians to 'read between the lines' – as they complained they had to do – Paul's intent was to write only what they could easily read and understand...One of the functions of the letter carrier was to read the letter and answer any questions that the recipients might have had. With Paul's letters, however, there are no hidden meanings or obscurities that require the on-the-spot explanations of a carrier. What he says he means.

Paul was NOT an IMPULSIVE LIGHTWEIGHT --- You could COUNT On him Knew COMMAND of Our MASTER and did his BEST to OBEY

Jesus: "Let what you say be simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything more than this comes from evil."

Matthew 5.37

But even as Paul MADE a PROMISE – He know ONLY God could KEEP IT

I hope to spend some time with you, if the Lord permits. 1 Corinthians 16.7

GEORGE FOX – English, Evangelical QUAKER in 1600's
Widely RESPECTED – Humble, Honest, Direct, Spoke UNVARNISHED Truth
Quakers moved to NEW ENGLAND – Pennsylvania – HONEST Businessmen
SO Honest became WEALTHY - People TRUSTED doing Business w/ them

It is essential that Christian ministers...be clear in their own minds about the proper priorities in ministry...making clear his identity to the congregation as a person under authority...ready in any given situation to do what through God's word, circumstance, conscience, or godly counsel the Holy Spirit is leading toward...Paul's example suggests that one must learn when to follow a plan and when to depart from it. This wisdom comes partly through experience, partly through the Word and Spirit's guidance, and partly from knowing ahead of time what the priorities are in one's ministry.
