WESTERNIZATION = SECULARIZATION > Varying Degrees Every Country
MODERN Western Society > GIVING is NONE of your BUSINESS
WE HAVE because we are ENTITLED – We WORK HARDER - SMARTER

Ours is the first major civilization built deliberately and self-consciously without religious foundations. Beneath other civilizations there have always been religious foundations...idols, gods, Islam, Hinduism, Christianity ... QUESTION Now about PRESENT Readiness – R U Grow Weary or Distracted? Word for MILITARY Action – Readiness – On HIGH Alert! – NO Surprises

NOT Unspiritual or Legalistic to ASK church to Make FINANCIAL Promise NOT Tell them HOW or HOW MUCH but does tell them to be READY

b. Shameful Slack

Paul uses REVERSE Psychology > Prevent EMBARRASSMENT for ALL

So give proof before the churches of your love and of our boasting about you to these men.

2 Corinthians 8.24

Paul wants Corinthians to Respond POSITIVELY to Coming DELEGATION v. 3 But I am sending the brothers so that our boasting about you may not prove empty in this matter, so that you may be ready, as I said you would be.

IMPORTANCE of Saving Face – Corinthians, Macedonians & their Father Paul From ALL APPEARANCE Corinthians had PLENTY they COULD Give

v. 4 Otherwise, if some Macedonians come with me and find that you are not ready, we would be humiliated—to say nothing of you—for being so confident.

Paul wants Corinthians to know you Cannot CLAIM to FOLLOW Jesus And ONLY Give when SHAMED to Do So by the Pressure of OUTSIDERS

c. Sends Servants

Church BAPTIZED in CA – Grew in X as HS/College Student

Supported US in Mission for 30 years – Home Every 3 years – Smaller, Smaller

NEXT to Last Visit – New Pastor – 10 People (incl Me & Dayna!)

New Pastor asked Treasurer RIGHT to SIGN Checks > Name of Property Deed

CHURCH almost became ATM Machine CON-ARTIST Called self PASTOR!

LAWYERS/ POLICE/ TEARS: Re-Opened Doors New Church Preaching Jesus

MODEL Established in Acts 6 – Servant-Leaders focus on Material Needs

So APOSTLES can Focus on WORD/PRAYER – Not be Tempted/Accused

v. 5 So I thought it necessary to urge the brothers to go on ahead to you and arrange in advance for the gift you have promised, so that it may be ready as a willing gift, not as an exaction.

Paul TRUSTING Church & TEAM Sent to COMPLETE Important TASK

He will EXHORT them but NOT be ORGANIZER > Teacher Not Treasurer

- 2-fold TASK of Titus:
- 1. Make Certain Offering READY by time Paul COMES
- 2. Make sure Gift is given JOYFULLY & GENEROUSLY NOT Grudgingly

Titus' VISIT will BUY TIME for them to Get Ready before PAUL will ARRIVE Paul wants to MAKE Sure that is BOASTING is Not 'full of hot air'

2. Promises to Claim

- a. Bounty from God
- v. 8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.

GIVER Benefits – ALL GRACE ABOUNDS 'abound' 6 X's / 'grace' 10 X's READING this VERSE like Drinking from FIRE HOSE of Mercy/Grace "Absolutely, Everything, All the Time, No Fooling, Sufficient Grace?" YES!

PRIMARY Focus of Context > MATERIAL Benefit – Gospel Truths

Bible > No Spiritual / Sacred Distinction – All FOR God – Seen/Unseen

All of LIFE is under God's Lordship AND Leading > Spiritual PURPOSE

All we POSSESS is BECAUSE of God's Grace > God IS ABLE / Powerful v. 8

You received without paying; give without pay. Matthew 10.8

MORE than Mere REPLENISHMENT – Overflow ABUNDANCE is GIVEN

v. 10 He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness.

SELF-Supporting > God will give YOU so you CAN be God-DEPENDENT I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. Philippians 4.11 If we have food and clothing, with these we will be content. 1 Timothy 6.8

TV: AMERICAN is WORRIED about TARRIFS Raising Price of Items in USA Entire 20-Foot CONTAINER Stacked High Plastic Boxes > Filled Sports Shoes All Brands, Colors, Styles – HUNDREDS of Pairs – Costing 1000's of Dollars

WORRIED that Tariffs might RAISE the Cost of BELOVED SNEAKERS

Thought MORE Worried PROBLEM Only has 2 FEET – Time to Short to Wear

As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy.

1 Timothy 6.17

NT does NOT Condemn RICHES or RICH PEOPLE > They're RESPONSIBLE As WE ALL are – God's Gifts ON LOAN – We STEWARD what He Entrusted

NEVER that was RICH till moved to RURAL Uganda during Civil Wars 1980's Long Way before SEE Equity & Justice Paul prayed for in GLOBAL Church

b. Believe the Gospel

v. 7 Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

GIVING is an OUTPOST of the KINGDOM of God – REVEALS His RULE

Giving NOT matter of SHOWING HOW Thankful we ARE

Our job is NOT to PROVE our SINCERITY to GOD

Giving is Act of FAITH in RESPONSE to GRACE

Not Deciding to DO Something FOR the Church – WE ARE the Church

Not MATTER of how MUCH One Gives, but HOW do you Give? Freely?

Not Give PERCENTAGE or TARGET Amount – but a HEART CHECK

Asking "HOW MUCH" we HAVE to Give is to Completely MISS Paul's Point

- v. 7 3 GUIDELINES for Giving
- "each one" INDIVIDUAL Matter You Decide, You are RESPONSIBLE
 How Much? Determined Not by Church or Comparing but Conviction
- 2. "decided" RESOLVE Verb found ONLY HERE in NT 'choose deliberately' Based on CALCULATED Decision Not Settled LIGHTLY or IMPULSIVELY NOT when OFFERING Plate is Coming Seconds ticking on QR Code > Home! LOVE that Existential ENCOUNTER > Face to Face with GOD @ Offering Bag Some Tell Unbelievers in Church You Don't have to GIVE --- REALLY?? You OWE Nothing to God? God gave you NOTHING? Paul's PRIMARY concern was their SOULS > Wants them DELIVERED from GREED, SELF-RELIANCE, COVETOUSNESS, HARD-HEARTEDNESS See Everything as GIFT of GRACE and TRUST God for the FUTURE

c. Bestow Grace

v. 6 The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

Quote? MAXIM? Known Saying? NOT Exactly QUOTE of Hebrew Scripture

PRINCIPLE – We HARVEST in PROPORTION to our PLANTING

Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap.

Galatians 6.7

2 Ways to SOW --

One – Take Precious SINGLE Seed like Gold Coin – Carefully place in Furrows Other: Recklessly GRAB Overflowing Handfuls, Wildly Throw in All Directions

Whenever fleshly reason calls us back from doing good through fear of loss, we should immediately oppose it with this shield: *But the Lord declares that we are sowing.*John Calvin

See LACK of Emphasis in Mainstream Evangelicalism as LACK of FAITH
If you REALLY Believed in God/Power you would CLAIM his PROSPERITY

Non-Prosperity Xtians accuse P's of MATERIALISM / Manipulating GOD

BOTH > Connect MONEY and FAITH > Both Extremes have WEAKNESSES

Evangelicals Give from GRATITUDE for What God HAS already GIVEN

Prosperity Gives in Anticipatory Gratitude for What God WILL Give

One LOOKS BACK @What they Have, Other looks FORWARD @WILL Have
Evangelicals FOCUS on PAST – Prosperity LOOKS to FUTURE
Both see GIVING as RESPONSE to Money – DO HAVE or WILL HAVE

BOTH make IDOLS Out of MONEY!

One its PROOF of His Truth/Power // Other, it's PROMISE of His Truth/power So REMOVE Money – Remove GOD, Blessings, Truth, Power, FAITH

Paul is calling Corinthians to TRUST God NOW to Meet their Needs

AND also to Meet Needs of POOR Jewish Christians in JUDEA – Here & Now

GIVE NOW Because your JOY and SECURITY are IN GOD who Cannot LIE

TRUST in Heavenly Father who CLOTHES FIELDS and FEEDS the BIRDS

v. 11 You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God.

Call to GIVE > FLEE Idolatry of TRUSTING Self & Savings — Not Savior What Paul PROMISES the GENEROUS Giver is NOT Wealth-in-Return But having ALL YOU NEED to be GENEROUS to Others

The key to generosity is not in caring less about what we have in the world, but caring more about God's purposes in granting to us his gifts. Kent Hughes

3. Possessions to Cherish

a. Righteousness

v. 9 As it is written, "He has distributed freely, he has given to the poor; his righteousness endures forever."

Def: Moral Uprightness – Covenant Blessing – Goodness – Eternal Life

NOT Saved by WORKS – But True Salvation WORKS > Received > GIVE

NOT Self-Dependence but GOD Dependence > HE is Jehovah Jireh our Provider

Giving must be generous and joyful because only such giving is an expression of faith in God as the one who provides the gracious means to being righteous.

ANY Righteousness WE have is a GIFT from our God of RIGHTEOUSNESS

v. 10 He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness.

FARMER has to WAIT for the HARVEST

GRACE GIVER begins to REAP God's Gracious Harvest IMMEDIATELY
Sure there ARE Long-Range BENEFITS – but they begin RIGHT AWAY too

Paul's thoughts are SHAPED by ISAIAH and HOSEA...

Paul sees CHURCH as NEW Covenant Community > JUBILEE in Jesus

"For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater"

Isaiah 55.10

"Sow for yourselves righteousness; reap steadfast love; break up your fallow ground, for it is the time to seek the Lord, that he may come and rain righteousness upon you."

Hosea 10.12

'seed' and 'harvest' NOT JUST Material Possessions > Seed of God's WORD
PROMISE Not to Make People Rich > Make the Instruments of SALVATION
Summary moves from COLLECTION TO EVANGELISM

No such thing as SECULAR & SACRED in Xtian Life > ALL is FOR God MONEY used for God's Glory & Kingdom SPIRITUAL Tool HE will USE

"All the money needed to send and support an army of self-sacrificing, joy-spreading ambassadors is already in the church."

b. Rejoicing

v. 12 For the ministry of this service is not only supplying the needs of the saints but is also overflowing in many thanksgivings to God.

Collection is GOSPEL Ministry because it RESULTS in PRAISE to God Praise for WHAT He's DONE in Past – PRAYER for what He'll do in FUTURE

Very WEALTHY Xtian Man prayed Daily/Faithfully for Many Mission Works
One day Son said, "Dad, if I had YOUR Money I could answer All your Prayers"

Might be GOOD Exercise to ASK who is Thanking God for YOUR Generosity?
WHO is Thanking God for GIVING of BICF – esp ZGC English Congregation?
WHO will we SEE in Heaven because WE Gave?

Who is Moving Forward in STRENGTH and Wholeness because We HELPED?

Love is the overflow of joy in God which gladly meets the needs of others...It originates in the grace of God which overflows because it delights to fill the empty...The contentment of a Christian...is not a Buddha-like serenity, unmoved by the hurts of others. PRAISE is Because...

1. OBEDIENCE Accompanies CONFESSION of the GOSPEL

Impact of Surpassing GLORY and Surpassing GRACE

We can give without loving, but we cannot love without giving. Linda Belleville HEARTS will GO Out to GIVERS & PRAYERS Go Up to God for the Givers Paul speaking about GIFT of MONEY > Can be applied to ALL God's GIFTS Let us take Our Gifts – Given by God, Recognized by Church – Share Them As we give GENEROUSLY, CHEERFULLY Lord of the Harvest is Praised!

Paul's THEOLOGY and PRAXOLOGY always ends in DOXOLOGY

Paul needs to INVENT a NEW Word – Never in NT or other Greek Literature

WORDS cannot DESCRIBE Gift of GOD that is BEYOND Description

The DIVINE Gift Exceeds ALL OTHER Gifts
WONDER of God's Gift Far EXCEEDS Every Attempt to Describe It

GREATEST Example of GIVING – God gave SON – JESUS gave LIFE – SPIRIT gives All GLORY to Jesus – Transformed Christians give STRANGERS
