NOWHERE in NT – Jesus or Apostles IMPOSE Faith on ANYONE Christian GOSPEL is NOT SHARIAH Law > You Want to WALK AWAY? GO! But Jesus WEPT – and we should WEEP TODAY – When People Walk Away! ARE you SERIOUS?
