The apostles did not go into these cities to do miracles, and then preach. Rather it was the other way around: They went to preach; then sometimes there were healings.

Already seen – NT Miracles SPONTANEOUS, NEVER SCHEDULED WHATEVER Circumstances > Paul FOCUSED on PREACHING CHRIST

STRATEGY in Most Cities – BEGIN in SYNAGOGUE > No Synagogue?? v. 19 Then some *Jews came from Antioch* and Iconium and won the crowd over.

Throughout Acts > GOSPEL Causes TROUBLE and MISUNDERSTANDING ABSOLUTE CLAIM > ONLY Jesus SAVES > ALL other Ways are WRONG! Parallel to Acts 3 / Lame from BIRTH, Looks DIRECTLY at Apostle, Healed REACTION of PAGAN, SUPERSTITIOUS, CROWD is VERY DIFFERENT a. Language

v. 11 the crowd saw what Paul had done, they shouted in the Lycaonian language...

MOST LIKELY PAUL DID NOT SPEAK THIS LANGUAGE

THOUGHT THEY WERE EXCITED ABOUT POWER OF TRUE GOD

REACTION – for a Few Minutes thought 'Oh, we must have come on Feast Day!

Thought were PRAISING God – NOT PROCLAIMING they WERE GODS

6,500 LANGUAGES IN WORLD - About 1,000 Whole BIBLE / 2000 Portions For these to HEAR God's VOICE – Languages Learned – Scripture Translated

ALL of US STORIES to TELL about the CONFUSION/COMEDY of Languages

- b. World-View way a person Perceives Reality / Looks at Life
- v. 12 Barnabas they called Zeus, and Paul they called Hermes because he was the chief speaker.

Jews: GOD HOLY, TRANSCENDENT vs. Gk. gods Came down to fool people GREEK RELIGION - ZEUS, chief god / HERMES - messenger god Barnabas = ZEUS - OLDER? More DIGNIFIED? / HERMES = Speaker/PAUL

The crowd's superstitious even fanatical behavior is hard to comprehend, but some local background throws light on it. About fifty years previously the Latin poet Ovid had narrated in his Matamorphses an ancient local legend. The supreme god Jupiter (Zeus to the Greeks) and his son Mercury (Hermes) once visited the hill country of Phrygia, disguised as mortal men. In their incognito they sought hospitality but were rebuffed, a thousand times. At last, however, they were offered lodging in a tiny cottage, thatched with straw and reeds from the marsh. Here lived an elderly peasant couple called Philemon and Baucis, who entertained them out of their poverty. Later the gods rewarded them, but destroyed by flood the homes which would not take them in. It is reasonable to suppose both that the Lystran people knew this story about their neighborhood and that, if the gods were to revisit their district, they were anxious not to suffer the same fate as the inhospitable Phrygians.

- c. Religious Structure RELIGIOUS HIERARCHY "priest of Zeus"
- v. 13 The priest of Zeus, whose temple was just outside the city, brought bulls and wreaths to the city gates because he and the crowd wanted to offer sacrifices to them.

Zeus was the most widely worshipped God in Galatia...(and) was often linked with the other gods. In the territory of Lystra there are carvings and inscriptions which show Zeus accompanied by Hermes.

e. Human Heart

## 2. Message to Pagans – Known to Unknown

EARLY Sermons in Acts – BELIEVERS in YAHWEH – Here PAGAN Gentiles Sermons to Jews: Based on COVENANT / to Gentiles: Based on CREATION ABSTRACT- Paul's ONLY RECORDED Message to ILLITERATE PAGANS

- a. God the Creator God's CREATION gives WORDLESS WITNESS to God
- v. 15 ...turn from these worthless things to the living God, who made heaven and earth and sea and everything in them.

BEGIN at BEGINNING - CREATION, PROVIDENCE - KNOWN to Unknown

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.

Psalm 19.1

Paul and Barnabas pointed to God's self-disclosure through the world he created and sustains, which the Lystrans observed every day.

God CREATED ALL PEOPLE – Jew and Gentile – Able to REASON and THINK

v. 15 "Men, why are you doing this? We too are only men, human like you."

#### b. God the Provider

v. 17 Yet he has not left himself without testimony: He has shown kindness by giving you rain from heaven and crops in their seasons; he provides you with plenty of food and fills your hearts with joy."

ALL that PEOPLE NEED and ULTIMATELY DESIRE – ONLY Found IN GOD JOY > GOD'S GREAT GIFT - NOT from SUBSTANCES – SEX – SELF Attained

These all look to you to give them their food at the proper time. When you give it to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are satisfied with good things. When you hide your face, they are terrified; when you take away their breath, they die and return to the dust. When you send your Spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the earth.

c. God the Judge v. 16 In the past, he let all nations go their own way.

TWO ERAS of God's RELATIONS to GENTILE NATIONS 'in the past...'

d. God the Savior v. 15 We are bringing you good news...

Luke's SYNOPSIS of Paul's Sermon in LYSTRA > emphasis UNIQUENESS PERHAPS Interrupted by STONE Throwing MOB

Paul's PURPOSE in Ministry was to PREACH CHRIST and His CROSS

For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.

1 Corinthians 2.2

THIS is the EVANGEL – GOOD NEWS – of Life, Salvation, Forgiveness, Heaven

We need to learn from Paul's flexibility. We have no liberty to edit the heart of the good news of Jesus Christ. Nor is there ever any need to do so. But we have to

begin where people are, to find a point of contact with them. With secularized people today this might be what constitutes authentic humanness, the universal quest for transcendence, the hunger for love and community, the search for freedom, or the longing for personal significance. Wherever we begin, however, we shall end with Jesus Christ, who is Himself the good news, and who alone can fulfill all human aspirations.

## 3. Ministry of Paul and Barnabas – Evangelism and Discipleship

## a. Example

vs. 19,20 They stoned Paul and dragged him outside the city, thinking he was dead. But after the disciples had gathered around him, he got up and went back into the city. The next day he and Barnabas left for Derbe.

LYSTRA Citizens OFFENDED by Paul & Barnabas REFUSAL of their Worship

When a person is stoned until he becomes unconscious and is then dragged out of the city, perhaps deeper than the physical pain is the mental anguish and the pain of utter humiliation.

- v. 21 They preached the good news in that city and won a large number of disciples.

GREAT to be with NEW, ENTHUSIASTIC, APPRECIATIVE Believers MORE AFFIRMING of your Efforts than ANTAGONISTIC UNBELIEVERS

v. 20 he got up and went back into the city

MUST NOT be FULLY CONSUMED by Caring for NEW CONVERTS

MANY Converts >> MANY, MANY, MORE who have NOT YET BELIEVED!

RETRACED STEPS Visiting DANGEROUS CITIES > Meet CHURCHES

Not about their DIGNITY – SAFETY – REPUTATION >> WISDOM

MAIN GOAL is ADVANCEMENT of CHURCH in NEW PLACES

c. Encouraged God directs Believers even THROUGH their SUFFERINGS

vs. 21,22 Then they returned to Lystra, Iconium and Antioch, strengthening the disciples and encouraging them to remain true to the faith. "We must go through many hardships to enter the kingdom of God," they said.

Barnabas = Son of Encouragement / Church grew in Atmosphere of LOVE & JOY

Barnabas had the biggest heart in the early church.

Evangelist BILL GLASS – Preaching to over 1000 PRISONERS

"How many had someone say 'You're so bad, someday you'll end up in prison!"

Nearly EVERY HAND went UP! – PARENTS > Self-FULFILLING PROPHECY

Encouragement to Church > God is with You > CHURCH BELONGS to God MEN will Leave > But GOD Stays

- d. Elders Appointed TEAM Ministry > Left them w/ BIBLE & BOARD Elders
- v. 23 Paul and Barnabas appointed elders for them in each church and, with prayer and fasting, committed them to the Lord, in whom they had put their trust.

This is FIRST Reference to ELDERS OUTSIDE of Jerusalem

NEVER Find CHURCH in NT Led by ONE MAN – Always a TEAM of ELDERS

TEAM Likely: Part-time / Full-time – Men / Women – Paid / Volunteer

I do not know how 'elderly' these elders were, but I know they had not been Christians very long, since the gospel itself had not been known to them very long. Was this any way to establish a church? Most Presbyterians wouldn't do it that way. We want to be slow, careful, dull, and (maybe) ineffective. But Paul had faith in what God was doing, and if there were to be churches in these cities, they obviously needed sound organization. So Paul appointed elders, more than one, and the churches thrived.

EXAMPLE of HOME Church in ANTIOCH that SENT them OUT on Mission

In the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul.

vs. 24-26 After going through Phisidia, they came into Pamphylia, and when they had preached the word in Perga, they went down to Attalia. From Attalia they sailed back to Antioch, where they had been committed to the grace of God for the work they had now completed.

LOOKING BACK > CLEARER Evidence of God's Gracious Guidance

Joseph to his brothers: "You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives." Genesis 50.20

By God's GRACE – FINISHED Well – MARK Quit – RAN HOME in FEAR PAUL & BARNABAS – TOUGHED it OUT to GOD-APPOINTED Conclusion

I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me--the task of testifying to the gospel of God's grace.

OVER 30 yrs ago > MY Life Verse – HOPING God Enables Me to Fulfill

LAST Chapter Paul Wrote – SHORTLY Before Executed for PREACHING Gospel

#### f. Educated the Church

NATURAL that Church that SENT THEM receives REPORT of their WORK

Met ANGLICAN Bishop of KAMPALA – Last saw 20 yrs ago – Both Theol Ed.

Walked into office at All Saint's Cathedral – "TELL ME THE STORIES!"

"Let me hear what God is DOING in YOUR LIFE --- in BEIJING!"

NO Cathedral in Antioch – PROBABLY Bishops – EAGER, Interested Church

Paul LOVED to TELL the Stories of how GOD OPENED DOORS for GOSPEL

I went to Troas to preach the gospel of Christ and found that the Lord had opened a door for me 2 Corinthians 2.12

Pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Colossians 4.3

CHAINS will NOT CLOSE DOORS – IF the SOVEREIGN Lord wants to OPEN

a great door for effective work has opened to me, and there are many who oppose me.

1 Corinthians 16.9

CONVENTIONAL Wisdom – MANY OPPONENTS = CLOSED DOOR!

SENDING Churches and those SENT Need REMINDERS > GOD opens DOORS

ADVERSITY can be the DOOR of OPPORTUNITY for the MESSAGE of Christ

g. Enriched v. 28 And they stayed there a long time with the disciples.

DISCIPLE – 28 X's in Acts – FAVORITE word for Believers 'FOLLOWER'

John describes way MISSION WORKERS were Sent OUT by Church in Ephesus

They have told the church about your love. You will do well to send them on their way in a manner worthy of God.

3 John 6

Hope that SOME OF YOU have SUCH CHURCHES Behind You – Sent Like God Approx ONE YEAR of Missionary SERVICE – Now REST for WINTER

Missionaries are not to be sent, gone, and forgotten: a line of communication is to remain so that both communities can be connected and blessed by seeing how God is working and binding them together.
