a. Scriptures v. 51 Have you understood all these things? they answered, Yes Love to watch SECRET VIDEO - If one of them Uplifted to WEB DEER in HEADLIGHTS Moment – Understand?? – STAMMER...Yeah??

Parables of Kingdom > Most Puzzling sections of the Word of God LOOK quite Simple & OBVIOUS on Surface > Deeper Truths must be Revealed Disciples had to have PRIVATE Tutorials with Son of God to get a CLUE

It is as wrong to say that Matthew has portrayed them as understanding everything as it is to say they understood nothing. The truth lies between the extremes.

Who could say - even 2000 yrs of Faithful Interpretation available Us – Yes?!

But Disciples said "Yes" - Believed all they Understood - Prepared to Act on it

That is what is Required of All who Hear the Gospel Message

Do you understand these things? Are you prepared OBEY?

Some say NO, I won't OBEY God until I am Convinced, He PROVES Himself

No Banks in Ancient World > Safest Place most People thought of Bury Ground Problem: What if you FORGOT the Location, or Failed to tell Friend you DIE GREAT Day to have a METAL DETECTOR > Abundance of Buried Treasures

Servant Working for Owner of Field > WHAT IN that Field Belonged to Owner Finds Treasure – Looks around Carefully hoping No One Notices – Buries It Hopes will Remember SPOT – Might take LONG Time to Work earn Payment

TREASURE is WORTH – All EFFORT it will take to BUY that FIELD
Whole LIFE is NEVER going to be the SAME – All things Now CHANGE

Perhaps person See the Value of Discovery but Decides - Too Much Trouble

Have to Adjust Priorities - Have to Sell his Goods, Change Lifestyle, Work Hard

This Man determined to Acquire the Treasure for himself

Some Not particularly anxious to find Christ—Not even very Interested in Faith Going own Way > Unexpectedly confronted by Gospel - Never heard it Before 16 yr. Happy Long Haired HS kid in Sunny Southern California – Great Family Went to YMCA camp Easter Week 1972 – Friends, looking for LOTS of FUN Announced Chapel – Bible Study --- SAY WHAT?? Girls went, Me TOO!

Once you Comprehend Wonder of Kingdom > Nothing Else Compares

Saw MYself as Sinner in need of Savior > Jesus was my God-sent Savior

"I revealed myself to those who did not ask for me; I was found by those who did not seek me" Isaiah 65.1

We would say PERSON who walks away from Priceless Treasure is FOOL

But people are DOING it all the TIME – Happens every SUNDAY Right Here

Believe Need Irresistible Grace – God must OPEN Hearts – As read of LYDIA

Part of OPENING Heart to God is FILLING Heart with PASSION for Him

"I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked"

Psalm 84.10

"Because I love your commands more than gold, more than pure gold, and because I consider all your precepts right, I hate every wrong path"

### c. Searches

vs. 45, 46 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls, who, on finding one pearl of great value, went and sold all that he had and bought it.

Main Lessons of 2 Parables > 2 Men Found Treasure – Different Ways

Contrast > Man who found HiddenTreasure > Not Looking for it

Merchant > Finding the Pearl was Result of Long Quest

Jesus is not interested in religious efforts or in affirming that one can "buy" the kingdom; on the contrary, he is saying that a person whose whole life has been bound up with "pearls" – the entire religious heritage of the Jews? – will, on comprehending the true value of the kingdom as Jesus presents it, gladly exchange all and follow him.

D.A. Carson

Both had FOUR things in Common....

First, they recognized the value of what they had found.

Second, they determined to have it.

Third, they sold everything to make their purchase.

Fourth, they acquired the treasure.

First Man FALLS into the Kingdom – Very Little Effort – in One Hour 2<sup>nd</sup> Man Struggles to Enter Kingdom – Wm Cowper, lifetime Doubt

The kingdom is available to disciples only by grace through faith...but genuine faith involves embracing and yielding to God's reign, not simply acknowledging it and then passing it by as if it did not exist.

## 2. Troubles Faced

# a. Familiarity

vs. 54-57 and coming to his hometown he taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished, and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and these mighty works? Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary? And are not his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? And are not all his sisters with us? Mark 6 – Jesus called CARPENTER – Joseph died Jesus led Family Business Word for Carpenter > CONSTRUCTOR – Could work w/ WOOD or STONE Village Carpenter hardly Imagine being a TEACHER, No less a MESSIAH!

ORDINARINESS of Jesus was their cause of OFFENSE

How could this Young Man they watched Grow Up be God come to Earth?

How many BEIJINGERS have NOT Seen GREAT WALL or Forbidden City? Great Wonders – Within Easy Reach – Too Convenient, just TOO BUSY


Like youngest Son of Jesse – this SON of DAVID – does not Look Messianic

### b. Faithlessness

v. 58 And he did not do many mighty works there, because of their unbelief.

HOMETOWN Nazareth paid a HIGH COST – Jesus moved to CAPERNAUM!

UNBELIEF in Whole Person – Reject this Miracle-Working, So-Called Messiah

Refuse to be PERSUADED by Miracles, His Manner, or His Message

Jesus NOT a Circus Performer – his Mission was NOT a Carnival Show
Told Satan he would NOT turn STONES into BREAD

Wants them to know HIM as God and Savior – Not GENIE or SUPERMAN a spokesman for our modern world...

We no longer feel ourselves to be guests in someone else's home and therefore obliged to make our behavior conform with a set of preexisting cosmic rules. It is our creation now. We make the rules. c. Fire Last Parable in Matthew 13 > Fishing and Fishermen

Gathering of Fish > Followed by Separation of Good from Bad

FAMILIAR Picture to Jews along the Sea of Galilee – DRAGNET

Pulled by BOATS or MEN walking along the Lakeshore

Everything in Path will be PULLED into the NET – No Tires or Plastic Bottles

Fishermen will stand beside the sea. From Engedi to Eneglaim it will be a place for the spreading of nets. Its fish will be of very many kinds, like the fish of the Great Sea.

Ezekiel 47.10

Matthew TELESCOPES thru Minor Details and Rushes to Main Point: Judgment What, then, does the last parable teach that has not already been taught?

vs. 47-50 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net that was thrown into the sea and gathered fish of every kind. When it was full, men drew it ashore and sat down and sorted the good into containers but threw away the bad. So it will be at the close of the age. The angels will come out and separate the evil from the righteous and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Makes almost Same Points as Parable of Wheat and Weeds

FIELDS and FISH Grow until the Harvest – Gathering then a Separation

Both Parables > Work of Angels who do Gathering and Separating

Repetition of Key Phrases: vs. 40,49 "the end of the age"

vs. 42,50 "throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth"

Unique TRUTH of Parable may be what is Left Out

NOT TOLD - How the Fish got into the Water in the first place.

Nothing is said about their growth or lack of it.

No human workers, not even a devil > FOCUS on Separation of Good & Bad

New element is the Warning to the Wicked – Last Parable: GRIM END

STRANGE Story – FURNACE seems hardly a place for BAD FISH

"There is coming judgment, the fate of the ungodly will be terrible in that day."

Word judgment means "to Separate."

Hebrew, judgment refers chiefly to Work of Judge or Lawgiver

Greek, krisis literally means "to divide"

Jesus described Judgment as Thorough and Eternal Separation.

Here are four important facts about God's judgment.

1. It is thorough - Time for mixture in any form will be over.

Here we have mixture all the time - some good things, & evil

Redeemed People in church, but also the Devil's Children

Lord's Angels will Execute Judgment > PURIFY People & Place of God

## 2. It is determined

Previously Determined > Grounds for Separation. Saved & Lost will already have been established on earth.

Determined by Receiving Good Seed of Gospel

Have YOU believed in Christ – What have you DONE with JESUS? Have you laid aside Everything Else aside to Gain Him as your Treasure?

3. It is permanent Collecting of the Good Fish and Discarding of Bad

In that day the opportunity for repentance will be over.

The day for trusting in Jesus Christ will be past.

Lived in Uganda – FIRST Discovered New, Deadly VIRUS – AIDS, SLIM

Doctor friends at MULAGO Hospital – Largest in Kampala – DEATH House

Detect Virus – Pack them on BUS Home – Easier to Transport Living than Dead

Students infected at Makerere Uni – Spoke there to Christian Union

Some Men bragging were SOLDIERS for SLIM – Dying on Frontlines AIDS

Had Unprotected Sex with as Many Women as Possible – Infected Many!

Devil wants to LULL you to Carelessness / Jesus calls you to Wake Up

Do not listen to the devil's lies. - He cares nothing for you.

He is a condemned and evil - knows he must perish - sole delight taking captives

MAIN Point of Jesus' Parable > Terrible Fate not following Jesus Christ.

I am glad Jesus taught (about hell) rather than leaving it for his ministers to imagine. How could we say that the end will be so bad that it can only be adequately compared to an eternal burning? How could we say that it will produce an eternal "weeping and gnashing of teeth"? No mere human being would dare predict that fate for another human being. Yet that is what Jesus does. He has more to say about hell than does any other person in the Bible. James Boice

What is it that makes hell so terrible, according to Jesus Christ?

 $1^{st}$  Suffering > Wicked thrown into Fiery Furnace, "weeping & gnashing" Teeth  $2^{nd}$  Remembering > Blessings of one's Previous Life and Lost Chances

Jesus told how Abraham said to Man in Hell:

"Son, *remember* that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony" Luke 16.24–25

One of Most Chilling Statements in Bible > Rich Man is told to Remember

How he Enjoyed a Lifetime of Good Things without any Reference to God

Good things Gone Forever > had his Heaven on Earth > Never ENJOY Again

Lazarus tasted Hell here > Now enjoying God's Heaven FOREVER

2 People know FOR SURE True Condition of Spiritual State – You & God Not your PARENTS your PARTNER or even your PASTOR

You cannot be CERTAIN your PASTOR is Christian tell Meet Him there

GOD knows and YOU Know – GENUINE Follower or a NO-GOOD FISH
