v. 16 Paul was waiting for them (Silas and Timothy) in Athens

TOURED the City > NO LONGER in its Prime Glory > Still FASCINATING

Athens - Roman Empire's INTELLECTUAL METROPOLIS

v. 18 "A group of Epicurean and Stoic philosophers began to dispute with him."

EPICUREANS = Life is CHANCE – try to ESCAPE & ENJOY LIFE! STOICS = FATE is CONTROLLED – you must SUBMIT - ENDURE LIFE!

> ATHENS HELD THE GLORIES OF ANCIENT GREECE Center - Philosophy / Literature / Art / Democracy

Aesthetically Magnificent / Culturally Sophisticated Morally Decadent / Spiritually Dead

v. 19, 20 Then they took him and brought him to a meeting of the Areopagus, where they said to him, "May we know what this new teaching is that you are presenting? You are bringing some strange ideas to our ears, and we want to know what they mean."

ATHENS TALK RADIO: Craving new ideas / strange ideas / latest ideas

v. 21 (All the Athenians and the foreigners who lived there spent their time doing nothing but talking about and listening to the latest ideas.)

Pastor: "I am very impressed by your morning devotional singing"
Woman: "Oh that's how I time my boiled eggs > 3 vss for Soft > 5 vss for Hard

...having a form of godliness but denying its power.

Resurrection Viewpoint > JUST being Religious is BAD

Early Chs. of Romans > Problem of Religion > Try to Make Self Acceptable

If anyone else thinks he has reasons to put confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; in regard to the law, a Pharisee; as for zeal, persecuting the church; as for legalistic righteousness, faultless. But whatever was to my profit I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord...not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ"

Jesus came to FORGE a RELATIONSHIP Not to FOUND a RELIGION

2<sup>nd</sup> Challenge > Popular Idea - v. 23 God is UNKNOWABLE

Altar "TO AN UNKNOWN GOD" - fearfully wondered, forgot one?

Church: "Isn't he a great servant of God? What would God do without him?"

Inflated view of OUR OWN IMPORTANCE > Power of OUR MINISTRIES

v. 25 And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything, because he himself gives all men life and breath and everything else.

Paul Turns Tables on Athenians > God serves us! God sustains us! God will not be TAMED or DOMESTICATED like a HOUSEHOLD PET

5<sup>th</sup> Challenge > Popular Idea – God made different people from diff stock

Greeks, ESP. Athenians > Believed themselves Master Race / Superior Humans

NO ARYAN RACE / No Super Power Nations in God's Eyes No First World / No Third World STATUS under His Sovereign Analysis Everyone thinks they are the best / Everyone looks down on Everyone Else v. 26 "From one man he made every nation of men"

No matter COLOR of our Skin, Same Sin-Tainted blood of Adam in our Veins ONLY BLOOD OF THE LAST ADAM CAN REDEEM US ALL FROM SIN

6<sup>th</sup> Challenge > Popular Idea – Our life is a matter of Random Chance

Hawaii saying "Lucky you live Hawaii" / ONLY MATTER OF LUCK?

Is Life COSMIC ACCIDENT / CRUEL FATE / ULTIMATE MISTAKE?

v. 26 ...they should inhabit the whole earth; and he determined the times set for them and the exact places where they should live.

We have Father in HEAVEN > Not just ME counting my hairs in Shower Drain GOD HIMSELF NUMBERED THEM > I am His Slowly Balding Child

7<sup>th</sup> Challenge > Popular Idea – If there is a god, he must be very far off

Some – Even Christians! – call God "The man upstairs" / "The old man" PROMOTING IDEA that God is Drowsy, Distant, and Disinterested in Us

IDOLATRY > taking Name of God in Vain

We can only Rightly Call God > what He Teaches us to call Him Many names of God in Scripture > "Man Upstairs" is NOT ONE OF THEM

v. 27 God did this so that men would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from each one of us. `For in him we live and move and have our being.'

Paul APPROVINGLY QUOTES > 6<sup>th</sup> C Greek Poet EPIMENIDES ALL TRUTH IS GOD'S TRUTH > from Greek poets / godless Rock Stars

Bible GOES FURTHER THAN EPIMENIDES > or even the Koran Koran: "God is closer than your JUGULAR VEIN"/ Warm Fuzzy Feeling!

JESUS: PERSONALIZES Truth "I am with you always" Matthew 28.20

8<sup>th</sup> Challenge > Popular Idea – We can fashion god into our own image

Thus, we ultimately control him > We set the Agenda of Life and Eternity Some Venerate > Shrines, Graves > Places of Spiritual Power Some Wear > Charms and Jewels > Provide Spiritual Protection

v. 28 As some of your own poets have said, `We are his offspring.' "Therefore since we are God's offspring, we should not think that the divine being is like gold or silver or stone--an image made by man's design and skill.

# GOD IS LOVING HEAVENLY FATHER > Sovereign, Risen King CANNOT BE MANIPULATED OR CAJOLED

NO PLACE FOR IDOLS > Material or Mental, Ancient or Modern Idols and Amulets > Attempt to CONTROL God rather than Submit > Attempts to CONFINE – Him who is Infinite & Awesome

Greeks CLAIMED great LOGIC > IDOLATRY utter FOOLISHNESS
