

ON THE CONTRARY – he is EAGER TO PREACH IN ROME Everyone WANTED to Visit Rome at Least ONCE – Look, Stare, Wonder Paul Not want to Visit as TOURIST but as an EVANGELIST – Preach Christ

BIBLICAL PARADOX – Believer WANTS to do WHAT HE HAS TO DO TRUE IF HE IS WISE – AND WANTS JOY AND PEACE OF GOD

v.17 Righteous God makes us right righteously

How is being made righteous different from merely being forgiven?

"righteousness" English word: It is positional, no debts or liabilities, nothing against you

More is being promised here than mere forgiveness.


1. Our sins were laid on Jesus, and when we believe in him, we are pardoned. But that "wiped clean" slate is only half of Christian salvation.

2. We are declared "not guilty" AND "perfectly righteous."

SHORT DEFINITIONS OF THE GOSPEL

Q. 60: How are you right with God?

A. Only by true faith in Jesus Christ. Even though my conscience accuses me of having grievously sinned against all God's commandments and of never having kept any of them, and even though I am still inclined toward all evil, nevertheless, without my deserving it at all, out of sheer grace, God grants and credits to me the perfect satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ, as if I had never sinned nor been a sinner, as if I had been as perfectly obedient as Christ was obedient for me. All I need to do is to accept this gift of God with a believing heart.

Q. 61: Why do you say that by faith alone you are right with God?

A. It is not because of any value my faith has that God is pleased with me. Only Christ's satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness make me right with God. And I can receive this righteousness and make it mine in no other way than by faith alone.

Q. 62: Why can't the good we do make us right with God, or at least help make us right with him?

A. Because the righteousness which can pass God's scrutiny must be entirely perfect and must in every way measure up to divine law. Even the very best we do in this life is imperfect and stained with sin.

Q. 64: But doesn't this teaching make people indifferent and wicked?

A. No. It is impossible for those grafted into Christ by true faith not to produce fruits of gratitude.

Just as our Lord was crucified between two thieves...the gospel keeps two truths together,


1. God is holy so our sins require that we be punished.

The gospel tells us: "You are more sinful than you ever dared believe."

To forget this leads to license, permissiveness.

2. God is gracious so in Christ are sins are dealt with

The gospel tells us: "You are more accepted in Christ than you ever dared hope." To forget this leads to legalism, moralism.




EXPERIENCES OF THE GOSPEL

When I was about twenty years of age I was engaged more than ever in the duties of religion. I became strict, and watchful over my thoughts, words, and actions; and thought I must be very seriously religious, because I considered entering the ministry. I spent much time every day reading my Bible and praying, and I gave great attention to Sunday sermons. In short, I had a very good outside, and trusted entirely in my religious duties, though I was not then aware of what I was doing wrong.

Though I often confessed to God that I, of course, deserved nothing, yet still I harbored a secret hope of recommending myself to God by all these duties and all this morality. When I prayed affectionately, and felt some melting of my heart in love to him, I hoped God would thereby be moved to care for me. So, I thought that through my repenting and praising him and seeking him, I could make good steps toward heaven. When my heart seemed full of love and faith, I felt that God would be affected by that, and would hear my prayers for their sincerity. In other words, I healed myself with my duties. I told myself, "God must accept you, because look at how whole-heartedly you serve and seek him." Now here was the problem. The more I tried to love God with all my soul, the more I saw how little I really loved him. The more I sought a soft heart, the more I felt how hard my heart was, and I supposed it must be softened before Christ would accept me. One night I remember in particular, when I was walking alone, and I had opened such a view of my sin that I feared the ground would cleave asunder under my feet and become my grave. I saw it was impossible for me, after the utmost pains, to answer the demands of God's law. I saw it condemned me for selfish and angry and fearful and envious and lustful thoughts, which I could not possibly prevent.

Then, after a considerable time spent in such distresses, one morning I was alone and I saw that all my contrivances and projects to effect or procure salvation were utterly in vain. I had thought many times that the difficulties were very great, but now I saw them in a different light — that it was totally impossible to do anything toward delivering myself. The tumult that had been in my mind now quieted. I saw that all my prayers and repentances and feelings and obediences had not laid the least obligation upon God to bestow his salvation on me. Then I realized why they were of no avail. When I had been fasting, praying, obeying, I thought I was aiming at the glory of God, but I was doing it all for my own glory — to feel I was worthy. As long as I was doing all this to earn my salvation, I was doing nothing for God, all for me! I realized that all my struggling to become worthy was an exercise in self-worship. I was actually trying to avoid God as saviour, and to be my own saviour. i.e. I was not worshipping him, but using him.

Then, at that time, the true way of salvation opened to my mind. I saw so much of its wisdom and suitableness and excellence that I wondered how I ever was blind to it. I wondered why everyone did not see this way of salvation — not by my own contrivances, but entirely by the righteousness of Christ. I felt myself in a new world, and everything about me appeared with a different aspect from before. David Brainerd's Diary (1718-1747)



Every little touch would hurt my tender conscience. But one day, as I was passing through a field, suddenly I thought of a sentence, "your righteousness is in heaven," and with the eyes of faith, I saw Christ sitting at God's right hand. And I suddenly realized —

THERE is my righteousness. Wherever I was or whatever I was doing, God could not say, "where is your righteousness?" for it was right before him. I saw that my good frame of heart could not make my righteousness better nor a bad frame of heart make my righteousness worse, for my righteousness was Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever.

Now my chains fell off indeed! I felt delivered from slavery to guilt and fears. I went home rejoicing for the love and grace of God. Now I could look from myself to him, and I realized that all those weak character qualities in my heart were like the pennies that rich men carry in their pocket, when their gold is safe under lock and key. Christ is my treasure, my righteousness. Now Christ was my wisdom, righteousness, holiness, and salvation."

1505 Martin Luther left Law School > ENTERED MONASTERY age 21 NOT to Study Theology > but to SAVE HIS SOUL Boyhood trembled > Frowning Face of Jesus in Church > Righteous Judge ALL HIS YOUTH / Feared Death > FEARED JUDGMENT

DEVOTED SELF to Augustinian Orders / Fasted, Prayed, Confessed Sins CONFESSED MOST TRIVIAL SINS / TOOK MANY HOURS at a Time Superiors banned him from Confession Box UNTIL he has Something Serious

Meticulously followed Monkish Wisdom of Day / Make Self Righteous by Works

Later wrote to Duke of Saxony "If ever a monk could obtain heaven by his monkish works, I should certainly have been entitled to it…If I had continued much longer, I should have carried my mortification even to death"

Wise Spiritual Father / Vicar General of the Congregation / John Staupitz "Why are you so sad brother Martin?"

"I do not know what will become of me," Luther deeply sighed. STAUPITZ "More than a thousand times I have sworn to our holy God to live piously, and I have never kept my vows. Now I swear no longer, for I know I cannot keep my solemn promises. If God will not be merciful towards me for the love of Christ and grant me a happy departure when I must quit this world, I shall never with the aid of all my vows and all my good works stand before him. I must perish."

With those SURPRISING WORDS / Staupitz sent Luther to study Scripture TEXT WHICH JUMPED OFF THE PAGE TO LUTHER WAS Romans 1.17

4. God's Righteousness – what is the message? GREAT THEME of this LETTER to the ROMANS > Good, Right, Just

d. Who God is - quality, characteristic, attribute

LUTHER SAW this CLEARLY in STERN FACE of JESUS on CHURCH WALL UTTERLY CONSISTENT, COMPLETELY FAITHFUL, ALWAYS RIGHT

HOLY - "Your eyes are too pure to look on evil; you cannot tolerate wrong"

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e. What God does - activity, behavior

Learn this from Abraham "The Judge of all the earth will DO RIGHT" Gen 18.25

ROMANS – God's Righteousness SUPREMELY SEEN in Cross of Christ v. 17 "For in the gospel a righteousness from God IS REVEALED"

JESUS WAS PERFECTLY RIGHTEOUS "I always do what pleases Him" Jn 8.29

WAS BAPTIZED "to fulfill all righteousness" Matt 3.14

FULFILLED PROPHECY OF ISAIAH "I am bringing my righteousness near, it is not far away, and my salvation will not be delayed" Isa 46.13

RIGHTEOUSNESS and SALVATION are SYNONMS / Keep Covenant Promise

"You answer us with awesome deeds of righteousness, O God our Savior" P 65.5 "The Lord has revealed his righteousness to the nations" Psalm 98.2

f. What God gives - status, position

GOD MAKES US RIGHTEOUS – THIS IS THE GOOD NEWS OF GOD! FIRST 2 ALONE –God is Righteous, God Acts Righteously – NOT Good News TERRIFYING NEWS – WE'RE IN TROUBLE – WE ARE UNRIGHTEOUS

"Rescue me and deliver me in your righteousness" Ps 71.2 "In your righteousness bring me out of trouble" Ps 143.11

What made Luther love the God he previously hated / GOD GIVES Righteousness

JOHN STAUPITZ TO LUTHER "Look at the wounds of Jesus Christ, to the blood that he has shed for you; it is there that the grace of God will appear to you. Instead of torturing yourself on account of your sins, throw yourself into the Redeemer's arms. Trust in him, in the righteousness of his life, in the atonement of his death. Do not shrink back. God is not angry with you; it is you who are angry with God. Listen to the Son of God" "My mouth will tell of your righteousness, of your salvation all day long" Ps 71.15

TERM "Imputation" – application of the righteousness of X to sinner

JAMES BOICE "It is like putting the infinite moral capital of the Lord Jesus Christ into our empty bank account"

JOHN STOTT "The righteousness of God is God's righteous initiative in putting sinners right with himself by bestowing on them a righteousness which is not their own but his. The righteousness of God is God's just justification of the unjust, his righteous way of pronouncing the unrighteous righteous, in which he both demonstrates his righteousness and gives righteousness to us. He has done it through Christ, the righteous one, who died for the unrighteous."

HOW DOES GOD GIVE THIS RIGHTEOUSNESS? – by faith from first to last

Three Elements – Knowledge, Heart Response, Commitment

KNOWLEDGE – Faith in something or someone NOT EMPTY FEELING Content of our Faith recorded in Bible, Revealed in Christ

HEART RESPONSE - Expressed in LOVE for God, His Son, His Word

COMMITMENT - Not just Savior for others, MY SAVIOR, My Lord, My God

SPURGEON "Faith is not a blind thing, for faith begins with knowledge. It is not a speculative thing: for faith believes facts which are sure. It is not an unpractical, dreamy thing; for faith stakes its destiny upon the truth of revelation...Faith...is the eye which looks...Faith is the hand which grasps...Faith is the mouth which feeds upon Christ"

AUGUSTUS TOPLADY - wrote in

"Rock of Ages, cleft for me. Let me hide myself in thee. Nothing in my hand I bring, Simply to thy cross I cling; Naked, come to thee for dress; Helpless, look to thee for grace; Foul, I to the fountain fly; Wash me, Savior or I die."

6. From God's righteousness revealed by faith to our faith in that righteous God IT IS ALL GOOD / AND CONSISTENT WITH BIBLICAL TEACHING

QUOTE from Habakkuk = Faith is the WAY TO RIGHTEOUSNESS What we are talking about DOCTRINE OF JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH

LUTHER "This doctrine is the master and prince, the lord, the ruler and the judge over all kinds of doctrines...If this article of justification is lost, all Xtian doc-trine is lost at the same time...without it the church of God cannot exist for one hour"

GOOD NEWS of God's Righteousness is for ALL PEOPLE / PLACES

d. Religious – v. 16 "Jew First"

v. 13 "other Gentiles" – Roman Church largely a GENTILE CHURCH v. 16 "Jew First" - THEOLOGY and CHRONOLOGY

THEOLOGY - 9.4 "The people of Israel, Theirs is the covenants, the receiving of the law, the temple worship and the promises"

REMINDS THEM – Gospel is FROM the Jews and FOR the Jews OT – Jewish Book / Jesus and the Apostles – Jewish

CHRONOLOGY/Time – Jesus to Samaritan woman "Salvation is from the Jews"

Paul in Synagogue at PISIDIAN ANTIOCH to Jews "We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life we now turn to the Gentiles" A 13.46

TRAGIC REJECTION BURDENED THE HEART OF JESUS "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, BUT YOU WERE NOT WILLING" Lk 13.34

PARABLE OF TENANTS CONCLUDES – Jesus strong words to Jews "I tell you that the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit" Mt 21.43

1515 German professor was also in SPIRITUAL CRISIS / Intellectual not Moral DEVOUT CATHOLIC MONK

"I was a good monk, if ever a monk got to heaven by his monkery, it was I"

DESPITE Good MONKERY / No Peace w/ God / Prof: Bible at Wittenburg Uni

"I had greatly longed to understand Paul's letter to the Romans, and nothing stood in the way but that one expression 'the righteousness of God', because I took it to mean that righteousness whereby God is righteous and acts righteously in punishing the unrighteous...Night and day I pondered until...I grasped the truth that the righteousness of God is that righteousness whereby, through grace and sheer mercy, he justifies by faith. Thereupon I felt myself to be reborn and to have gone through open doors into paradise. The whole of Scripture took on new meaning, and whereas before 'the righteousness of God' had filled me with hate, now it became to me inexpressibly sweet in greater love. This passage of Paul became to me a gateway to heaven."

Dr. Martin Luther > moved by these words Romans > Father of Reformation

ROMANS 9 – 11 / Paul discusses Rejection of Jews / Reception of Gentiles TRAGEDY TODAY Most Jews think Jesus is ONLY FOR GENTILES

SURPRISING – Religious People, those who were promised Messiah REJECTED

NOT SURPRISING – No Religion – NOT EVEN Christianity – CAN SAVE US

RELIGION OFTEN INFLUENCES ONE to TRUST SELF – Ex. Paul/Saul Christian Gospel is about FULLY TRUSTING CHRIST, CHRIST ALONE

GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS IS FOR RELIGIOUS / often too proud to ask for it

e. Advantaged - "Greeks" / "wise"

PRIORITY for Jews Does NOT MAKE Gospel LESS RELEVANT for Gentiles

"Greeks and non-Greeks" OBVIOUS REFERENCE TO NATIONALITY

ADDITION of Phrase "wise and foolish" SOMETHING MORE MEANT

Greeks were the people of EDUCATIONAL PRIVILEGE & OPPORTUNITY Greeks – Great Historical Epic / Philosophers / GOOD NEWS FOR EDUCATED

CONTRARY TO MODERN IDEAS – Higher Education Largely Secular RELIGION PLAYS LITTLE OR NO PART IN MOST ACADEMIC CIRCLES

ACADEMIC WORLD – Produces REASONS WHY should IGNORE RELIGION EX - RELIGIOUS IDEAS RELATIVE – formed by CULTURAL FORCES

WEST – Xtian / ARAB or TURK – Muslim / ASIAN – Buddhist, Hindu, Shinto TRUE GENERALIZATION – MANY STARTLING EXCEPTIONS

QUESTION – What about the claims of Christ and the Bible? ARE THEY TRUE?

Paul spoke to Athenian philosophers / Greek academics – BRUSHED OFF IDEAS

"He seems to be advocating FOREIGN GODS" Acts 17.18

TRUE – Few in Athens HEARD GOSPEL of JESUS of NAZARETH / Foreign! PAUL "what you worship as something unknown I am going to proclaim to you" Acts 17.23 QUESTION NOT – Is it Foreign? // REAL QUESTION – Is it True?! EVERY TRUTH COMES FROM SOMEWHERE / Foreign to All / from Heaven OTHER CRITIQUES AND ATTACKS FROM SECULAR EDUCATION These have been answered by Bible believing scholars / READ WORKS

PAUL – one of the Brilliant Scholars of his day / WISDOM OF FAITH IN X

f. Disadvantaged - "non Greeks" / "foolish"

Anyone who was not Greek was a BARBARIAN / ICF many Barbarians LINGUISTIC – not a SOCIAL DESIGNATION – not too Offensive

Speech of Foreign Neighbors / Sounded like Stammering, Babble "bar, bar"

WITHOUT Knowledge of GREEK / Cut off- Cultural & Academic Storehouse

PERHAPS YOU FELT Disadvantaged, Limited, Cut off from Opportunities NOT ENOUGH EDUCATION, MONEY, CONNECTIONS WITH POWER

DANGER – Feel that Christianity is NOT FOR YOU / DO NOT QUALIFY GOSPEL FOR RICH AMERICANS / and FIVE-STAR HOTEL BALLROOMS

Jesus Christ did NOT go ONLY to Wise, Wealthy, Influential Citizens of His Day ALSO to EVERYDAY PEOPLE – Whoever and Wherever they Were "Friend of Outcasts and Sinners" – carpenters, fishermen, tax collectors, prostitutes

Peter to Cornelius – "God does not show favoritism but accepts men from every nation who fear him" Acts 10.35

Rom 2.11 "For God does not show favoritism"

CHURCH IS NOT A CLUB FOR "Our Kind of People" / WE DON'T OWN IT Not American, Korean, Kazakh, Russian – CHURCH of LORD JESUS CHRIST

IF CHRISTIANS HAVE PRESENTED our Faith as CLIQUISH or for Select Few

PLEASE ACCEPT MY APOLOGIES / misrepresentation of our God and Gospel

v. 15 "you who are at Rome" / MULTI-Cultural City /4 million from all World

MAY BE YOUNG PERSON – parents drag you here – SS stops at 10 years old!!

SPURGEON in a talk to Children – "You may be young; but you are old enough to sin, and you are old enough to die"

DIVERSE Family of Faith at ICF Displays - "Jesus, only Jesus, Savior of World"

JOHN MURRAY "The purpose of these classifications is simply that the gospel is for all without distinction of nationality or cultural development and that he as the apostle of the Gentiles is under divine obligation to preach the gospel to all."

6. Godly Response – what must we do?

d. Debt "obligated" – an obligation that must be discharged

UNDER DIVINE OBLIGATION TO PREACH GOSPEL TO ALL PEOPLE

"Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel!" 1 Corinthians 9.17

2 Kinds of Debt – 1. Taken something for Self / 2. Given something for Another** SEMINARY STUDENT – Mission Trip to Uganda / Country at War / Collapse Staying in Orphanage / Given Package to Carry / Difficult Travel FINALLY PRESENTED \$30,000 TO DIRECTOR OF ORPHANAGE

I was DEBTOR / NOT MY MONEY / Given that money for the Orphanage NOT OUR GOSPEL – From God – Must faithfully give Gospel to All People

NOT ALL HAVE THE GIFT OF EVANGELISM, or OFFICE OF EVANGELIST BUT ALL BELIEVERS are RESPONSIBLE to SHARE GOOD NEWS of Jesus

v. 16 "the gospel, because it is the power of God for salvation"

MORE THAN JUST TELLS ABOUT – or Announces – God's Saving Power THE GOSPEL ITSELF IS THE POWER

e. Delight "eager"

SEEMS A STRANGE RESPONSE TO A DUTY – Very UnAmerican Characteristic Response of Americans / Not Me / Nobody tells me what to do!

Paul NOT YET COME to Rome – NOT DUE to any RELUCTANCE of His ON THE CONTRARY – he is EAGER TO PREACH IN ROME Everyone WANTED to Visit Rome at Least ONCE in Life – Look, Stare, Wonder

Paul did not want to Visit as a TOURIST but as an EVANGELIST – preach Christ

BIBLICAL PARADOX – Believer WANTS to do WHAT HE HAS TO DO TRUE IF HE IS WISE – AND WANTS JOY AND PEACE OF GOD TRUTH DISCOVERED by Psalmist "I rejoice in following your statutes as one rejoices in great riches...I delight in your decrees, I will not neglect your word"

f. Determination "not ashamed"

STRANGE TO HEAR - Apostle who GLORIED in the Cross / BOASTED!

HONEST WORDS – even an Apostle of God is part Sinner, part Saint WRITING TO ROME – EPICENTER OF WORLDLY POWER GOD saves through Lifeless, Broken, Naked, Bleeding Man / CRAZY NEWS!

WORDS OF CONVICTION / DETERMINATION – thought and reflection HE KNOWS CRITICISMS, INTELLECTUAL ATTACKS, MOCKING LAUGH

FELT LIKE AN IDIOT – Porcius Festus – Roman Government Official said "You are out of your mind, Paul! Your great learning is driving you mad" 26.24

ABSENCE OF SHAME is a PROOF of FAITH

JESUS "If anyone is ashamed of me and my words....the Son of Man will be ashamed of him" Mark 8.38

PAUL'S FAREWELL LETTER TO TIMOTHY 2 Tim 1.8 "So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord or ashamed of me his prisoner."

LOGICAL PROGRESSION

- 5. He is ready to preach the Gospel
- 6. He is not ashamed of the Gospel
- 7. Because it is the Power of God for Salvation
- 8. Because in the Gospel the Righteousness of God is Revealed

GOD'S SAVING POWER is Operative through the GOSPEL ALONE Word of God living and active / Sword of the Spirit / Life Giving Good News

OPERATION – not UNCONDITIONAL or UNIVERSAL v. 16 "everyone who believes" SALVATION APPLIED THROUGH FAITH

TO SAY "I am NOT ASHAMED" – BOLD DETERMINATION "I have suffered the ridicule, counted the costs, I stand for Jesus & Him crucified" 3 COMMON RESPONSES of Modern Believers to EVANGELISM1. Option2. Reluctance3. Shame / Fear

MODERN BELIEVER "I do not have to evangelize, not my gift or interest" PAUL "I am obligated to preach"

MODERN BELIEVER "I do not want to evangelize, no one can force me" PAUL "I am eager to preach to all in Rome"

MODERN BELIEVER "I am ashamed to evangelize, what will people think? PAUL "I am not ashamed of the gospel"

1510 > 5 yrs as a Monk > 2 years Teacher of Bible Univ of Wittenburg FULFILLED LIFE LONG GOAL > Visit to the Holy City of Rome EAGER TOURIST > saw Shrines, Relics, Churches, heard Legends

Church of St. John Lateran in Rome / Medieval Stone Stairs ALLEGEDLY original Staircase from home of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem FAITHFUL climbed "Holy Stairs" on their KNEES, praying at each point KISSING STAINS on Stairs / Claimed to be from the Blood of Jesus DURING this Painful Devotion / Our Text filled Luther's mind "The just shall live by faith" / Realized he lived by FEAR not FAITH OLD SUPERSTITIONS fought against NEW BIBLICAL FAITH IN HIM "By fear" said Luther

"By faith" said the Apostle Paul

"By fear" said the scholastic father's of medieval Catholicism

"By faith" said the Scriptures

"By fear" said those who agonized with him on those stone Holy Stairs "By faith" said God the Father

Stood & walked down stairs / Rejecting Superstition / Embracing Scripture REAL BEGINNING OF REFORMATION / in heart of Martin Luther few years Change of Heart / swept across Europe / eventually World

Luther echoed Paul "I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God"
