Did Jacob tell Laban was 3rd Covenant Patriarch, Servant of True, Living God? His God – Maker of Heaven & Earth – Promised whole Earth blessed thru him? Descendants MANY as STARS of Sky & SANDS on Seashore? Probably NOT

These THINGS? Really Tired, Long Walk, Blisters, Terrible Internet Reception

Bible NOT tell us HOW Rachel (or Leah) felt toward JACOB

Was it PAIN of UNREQUITED Love? Jacob was Out There / Rachel SILENT

Here we are PEOPLE of God – Meeting NEW People in NEW City

Are we MACHO Men or MEN on MISSION for a MIGHTY God

Have we HIDDEN our Light UNDER a BUSHEL? Or is it SHINING!

My Wife always says "I am Dayna and I am a Christian" Crystal Clear, Yikes!!

Now Pastor – Is that a Real Job? – Used to have Real Jobs, always said: "I will work hard, I will work late, but I must go to church on Sundays!" It made the EMPLOYER MORE willing to HIRE ME! Never LACKED!
