HUMANITY > We cannot SEE the WHOLE Picture – Only God OMNISCIENT

b. Wives from Stealing

vs. 19-23 So they said, "Behold, there is the yearly feast of the LORD at Shiloh, which is north of Bethel, on the east of the highway that goes up from Bethel to Shechem, and south of Lebonah." And they commanded the people of Benjamin, saying, "Go and lie in ambush in the vineyards and watch. If the daughters of Shiloh come out to dance in the dances, then come out of the vineyards and snatch each man his wife from the daughters of Shiloh, and go to the land of Benjamin. LITTLE Word in v. 24 – Should REMIND Them and US – NOT About US!


