b. Precise Search

Intro of Ecclesiastes is intentionally similar to opening words of Proverbs
"The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel" Proverbs 1:1
"The words of the Teacher, son of David, king in Jerusalem" Ecclesiastes 1:1
Young king Solomon, humbly prayed for wisdom: Proverbs Reveal God's answer

He (Solomon) spoke three thousand proverbs and his songs numbered a thousand and five. He described plant life, from the cedar of Lebanon to the hyssop that grows out of walls. He also taught about animals and birds, reptiles and fish.

1 Kings 4.32,33

Author of Eccl. clear ref to Solomon > BUILDING on STATUS of Solomon

Solomon: Stopped at NOTHING > NO LIMIT to his BUCKS or his BRAINS

Solomon: Widely known as the WISEST and RICHEST man in WORLD

If Solomon could not find meaning in things of this world, who could?

b. Author? Human: Unknown / Primary: God the Holy Spirit

1) What gain would Solomon get by not naming himself?

One of greatest kings of Israel / Name NEVER occurs in entire Book

2) Time frame of writing does not fit Solomon

"I, the Teacher, was king over Israel in Jerusalem" Ecclesiastes 1:12

Solomon died while he was the ruler of Israel

Solomon reigned in Jerusalem over all Israel forty years. Then he rested with his fathers and was buried in the city of David his father.

1 Kings 11:42-43

3) Powerlessness of the author does not sound like Solomon

Author Laments OPPRESSION of POOR & ABUSES of Ruling RICH

If you see the poor oppressed in a district, and justice and rights denied, do not be surprised at such things; for one official is eyed by a higher one, and over them both are others higher still. The increase from the land is taken by all; the king himself profits from the fields

Ecclesiastes 5:8-9

It would be quite strange for the king to be protesting against himself!

Solomon could have done something! His power over Israel was absolute.

3. The Strategy we learn from Ecclesiastes

Most Books in Bible > God's Message TO World > KNOW, STUDY, BELIEVE Eccles: God's Message ABOUT the WORLD > Secular THOUGHTS & IDEAS

a. Listen to the World

IF we want to SPEAK to the WORLD > FIRST we must LISTEN TO THEM

When Moses sent them (*twelve Israelite spies*) to explore Canaan... "*See what the land is like* and whether the people who live there are strong or weak, few or many. What kind of land do they live in? Is it good or bad? What kind of towns do they live in? Are they unwalled or fortified? How is the soil? Is it fertile or poor? Are there trees on it or not?"

Numbers 13:17-20

God gave Solomon wisdom and very great insight, and a breadth of understanding as measureless as the sand on the seashore. Solomon's wisdom was *greater than the wisdom of all the men of the East*, and *greater than all the wisdom of Egypt*. He was wiser than any other man, including *Ethan the Ezrahite-wiser than Heman, Calcol and Darda, the sons of Mahol*. And his fame spread to all the surrounding nations. ...Men of all nations came to listen to Solomon's wisdom, sent by all the kings of the world, who had heard of his wisdom.
