

WHATEVER Reason – Abimelech wanted Abe's WIFE – God's Princess!

UNBROKEN CYCLE> Practiced by their Son Isaac > like Father, like Son

"When the men of that place asked him about his wife, he said, "She is my sister," because he was afraid to say, "She is my wife." He thought, "The men of this place might kill me on account of Rebekah, because she is beautiful."

Critical Scholars > See Literary Parallel > Bible has Mistake > Sloppy Redactors SLOPPY THING > Sinful Nature > Not Scripture > We Fall in Same Hole Again Abe & Sarah's Troublesome PLAN MADE MORE THAN 30 YEARS BEFORE

v. 13 "And when God had me wander from my father's household, I said to her, 'This is how you can show your love to me: Everywhere we go, say of me, "He is my brother." "

SKELETON in their CLOSET: Long time before made Decision to Compromise

They Grew in Faith & Maturity > Fail to Repent of Weakness > Bring into Light

"Oh, that was a long time ago, what does that matter now?"

30 Years Later > Foolish Pledge > Popped OUT and LED to DOWNFALL

Perhaps YOU need to REVISIT some COMPROMISE from your PAST

Saying – God being my helper – I determine to CHANGE - Walk in New Life

"put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness" Ephesians 4.22-24

d. Cruising Abraham FREE TO MOVE > Whole Land Belonged to Him

v. 1 "Now Abraham moved on from there into the region of the Negev and lived between Kadesh and Shur. For a while he stayed in Gerar"

Toward Mediterranean Sea – Land of Philistines - GERAR



UNDERSTANDABLE WHY HE'd WANT TO MOVE from Mamre
Fabulous View Now Grim Vista > Graves of Sodom and Gomorrah
Clean Air > Hazy, Putrid, and Sulfrous
Grass for Cattle to Graze > Scorched with Brimstone

FREE to Cruise > But should Cruise WITH Christ & FOR Him

ROLLING Stone gathers NO MOSS – Many prefer CHURCH HOPPING

BE ACUTELY SENSITIVE TO GOD'S PERSON AND PURPOSE > HOLY NOT AIMLESS WANDERING > BUT PURPOSEFULLY FOLLOWING

FINAL WORDS OF RISEN JESUS TO THE CHURCH > Marching Orders

"go and make disciples of all nations" Matthew 28.18

VERB not 'GO,' Verb is 'Disciple' > be about Making Disciples > COMMAND

GO ASSUMED > Go Here, Go There = Life > WHY DO YOU GO? Purpose??

Here to Follow Jesus: DISCIPLE = Follower > INVITE Others to FOLLOW

GIANT TANKER SHIPS > Carry Oil across World's Seas > 3 - 5 kms Full Stop

Engines CUT OFF 1 km Back, Appear to Observer going NORMAL COURSE

WALK with God: Appear to be Moving in Strength > Faith Summer Vacation?

OUTSIDE OBSERVER can be FOOLED by Appearances > But YOU KNOW!

ABE's statement in v. 13 "the gods caused me to wander"

TEMPORARILY ASLEEP ON HIS WATCH > Lapse of Memory

Clearly Called by a Sovereign God > CALL TO FOLLOW IN FAITH

Abe made what HE THOUGHT was GOOD PLAN > Failed > NOT God's Plan "God does not allow his children to sin successfully" Charles Spurgeon

## 2. Surprising Pagan

To UNBIASED READER > Abimelech is MORE RIGHTEOUS than Abraham Abimelech > TITLE = "God the King is My Father" > Another Abim. Gen 26

a. Communion few places in Bible > God speaks directly to an Unbelieverv. 3 "God came to Abimelech in a dream one night"

Theologians COMMON GRACE and SAVING GRACE

SAVING – through Jesus, revealed in Scripture, for God's Chosen People COMMON – for all people, revealed in Nature, benefit those on Earth COMMON GRACE referred to by Jesus: "He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous." Matthew 5.45

COMMON GRACE > Protects Society from Anarchy > Restrains Evil in Hearts

ABIMELECH also needs SAVING GRACE v. 3 "You are as good as dead because of the woman you have taken; she is a married woman."

WITHOUT SALVATION > Without Christ > "You are as good as dead"

God Loves all People > Paul tells unbelieving Gentiles in Lystra "He has not left himself without testimony" Acts 14.17

PRAY TO GOD THAT HE WILL AROUSE SLEEPING SINNERS
CALL THEM by GOSPEL DREAMS & VISIONS to REPENT & BELIEVE

- b. Conscience ALL PEOPLE been GIVEN GOD-SENSITIVE Conscience
- v. 6 "Then God said to him in the dream, "Yes, I know you did this with a clear conscience, and so I have kept you from sinning against me. That is why I did not let you touch her."

Abimelech is OBEDIENT to the LIGHT of Truth which HE HAD RECEIVED
Perhaps he LEARNED LESSON thru Judgment upon Sodom
Today SOME Mock Story of Sodom & CURSE God of JUDGMENT

v. 8 "Early the next morning Abimelech summoned all his officials, and when he told them all that had happened, they were very much afraid."

DANGEROUS > Continual ATTACK TODAY on our CONSCIENCE

Paul "I strive always to keep my conscience clear before God and man" Acts 24.16

c. Confrontation Dramatic Scene > Abe appears before entire Royal Court vs. 9,10 Then Abimelech called Abraham in and said, "What have you done to us? How have I wronged you that you have brought such great guilt upon me and my kingdom? You have done things to me that should not be done." And Abimelech asked Abraham, "What was your reason for doing this?"

ABE's LAME EXCUSE > Plays Blame Game > Old as Garden of Eden v.11-13 "Abraham replied, "I said to myself, 'There is surely no fear of God in this place, and they will kill me because of my wife.' Besides, she really is my sister, the daughter of my father though not of my mother; and she became my wife...I said to her, 'This is how you can show your love to me: Everywhere we go, say of me, "He is my brother." '

NOTHING MORE SHAMING for Believer > Confronted in sin by Unbeliever

Believer in H.S. > Out of Paganism > Drunken Evangelist > Jim Kuch – Son of Mormon Bishop in Town "If you really believe in Jesus, why are you drunk?"

Jim Kuch DIED about 15 years later from AIDS

### 3. Sovereign Purpose

Main Character NOT Abe or Abimelech BUT GOD

We learn about God & His Purposes > IRONY – Godless FEAR God

v. 8 So Abimelech rose early in the morning and called all his servants and told them all these things. And the men were very much afraid.

a. Patience – God does not Reject His Disobedient Children // like any Parent

Abimelech probably had MANY NAMES for Abraham

Coward, Hypocrite, Two-Faced, Charlatan > KZ – GOAT or SHEEP

God's view of Abraham does not change w/ Lame Excuses > Friend of God

v. 7 "Now return the man's wife, for he is a prophet"

God DID NOT IGNORE ABE'S SIN > He would Deal with It

#### BUT SIN DOES NOT ALTER OUR STANDING BEFORE GOD

Our STANDING is SECURE in CHRIST > Even 2000 years before Jesus Came "Your father Abraham rejoiced at the thought of seeing my day; he saw it and was glad."

John 8.56

CHANGE OF NAME > "No longer will you be called Abram; your name will be Abraham, for I have made you a father of many nations." Genesis 17.5

CHANGE OF NATURE > Irrevocably God's Man > CANNOT OUTRUN GOD

This Deceit and Cover-up > Ch. 20 > Lapse in Abe's Consistent Walk with God

As Child of God REPENTANCE not just Beginning of Christian Life
IT IS the Christian LIFE: Daily Business of Believer, Sinner under Construction
Covenant Promise > Needs to become Christian Possession > Repent & Believe

1. "When Jesus said "repent" he meant that believers should live a whole life repenting" Martin Luther

1st of 95 Theses nailed to All Saint's Church door in Wittenberg, 1517

- b. Pardon Again surprising how passage picture's God's pardon...
- v. 7 "Now return the man's wife, for he is a prophet, and he will pray for you and you will live."
- v. 17 "Then Abraham prayed to God, and God healed Abimelech, his wife and his slave girls so they could have children again"

Early History of Christian Church > DONATIST CONTROVERSY

Can Sinful Pastor be instrument of blessing? Dirty Sacraments? Obscure Word?

Minority > NO! Separated from Unholy Leaders > Where are you going to go? Where is the SEMINARY that Graduates SINLESS PASTORS?

No ORDINATION will REMOVE All Sin!

...the righteous falls seven times and rises again

Abraham deserved a Kick in the Pants > or Much Worse > Got MUCH BETTER

vs. 14-16 Then Abimelech brought sheep and cattle and male and female slaves and gave them to Abraham, and he returned Sarah his wife to him. And Abimelech said, "My land is before you; live wherever you like." To Sarah he said, "I am giving your brother a thousand shekels of silver. This is to cover the offense against you before all who are with you; you are completely vindicated."

Silver's Value > MORE than Laborer would earn in LIFETIME

VALID Concern: How can Holy God allow sinful Christians to do Holy Work?

Has not God thrown His Pearls before the Swine?

UNANSWERABLE Question: All Eternity will not Provide Answer – Why? WHY have you LOVED US GOD? Saved Us, Use us in your Kingdom Work?

Thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere... Who is sufficient for these things?

2 Corinthians 2.14,16

- c. Plan of God No Matter our Failures & Foibles > God's Purpose will Stand Sovereignly RESTRAINS Sin / Speaks to CONSCIENCE of Unbelievers OPENS and CLOSES Womb – God of LIFE
- v. 18 For the LORD had closed all the wombs of the house of Abimelech because of Sarah, Abraham's wife.

# SAVING His COVENANT People > "because of Sarah"

"This episode is chiefly one of suspense: on the brink of Isaac's birth-story here is the very Promise put in jeopardy, traded away for personal safety. If it is to ever be fulfilled, it will owe very little to man. Morally as well as physically, it will clearly have to be achieved by the grace of God."

Abraham's Shenanigans > Puts The PROMISED SON at Risk > Long Awaited Child of Promise > from **Abraham and Sarah** NOT Abimelech and Sarah NARRATIVE Version of Romans 8.28

And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

Romans 8.28

We DO what we DECIDE to DO – BUT it is according to God's DECREE Both TRUTHS are Taught Clearly in the Bible

God uses CHOICES of those who DON'T Know Him > For God's People
Even Uses PAGAN Presidents, Legislators, Courts, Civil Society, etc.
What it MEANS for Jesus to have ALL AUTHORITY in Heaven & Earth
Sometimes He orders things that HURT DEEPLY – 8.28 comes thru 8.29
For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image

of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

Romans 8.29

CONFORMED to be like JESUS means the CROSS

What God do you believe in? God who behaves nicely? What we consider reasonable and nice? Always does right thing for us? Can He do hard things? Why does He allow His people to get into a crazy mess?

d. Praise to God - God DELIVERED A & S DESPITE their ACTIONS

If Salvation DEPENDED on what WE DO, we would be TOAST!

But BIBLE DECLARES What GOD Does – All of Grace, All the Glory is His!

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age Galatians 1.3,4

He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Colossians 1.13,14

The Lord will rescue me from every evil deed and bring me safely into his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen. 2 Timothy 4.18
